A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN FOR GODALMING & FARNCOMBE – FINDINGS EXHIBITED

Volunteers and Councillors gathered at Godalming Museum on the morning of Tuesday, 29 March 2016 to be the first to see the Godalming & Farncombe Neighbourhood Plan exhibition. The exhibition is open between 10am and 5pm every day except Sundays and Mondays until the 16 April 2016.

The exhibition draws together work from each of the groups of volunteers working on the Plan and gives the town's residents the opportunity to explore the initial findings and to give feedback before the Plan itself is drafted. There is also the opportunity for younger residents to win prizes by revealing what they love most about the town – with a picture or in words.

The exhibition displays information explaining what a neighbourhood plan is; what work the volunteers have done to date; it sets out housing and transport priorities for the town with some of the supporting evidence and it asks visitors to think about what "heritage" in the town actually means.
