Farncombe Initiative – New Planter and Tree in Farncombe Street

On Saturday, 29 October Farncombe residents, Members of the Farncombe Initiative and Godalming Town Mayor, Councillor David Hunter, gathered together to see the installation of a planter and ornamental crab apple tree in Farncombe Street. The Farncombe Initiative is a community organisation supported and funded by Godalming Town Council and Surrey County Council, whose chairman is County & Town Councillor Steve Cosser.

The Farncombe Initiative aims to identify projects to enhance the areas which are important to local residents. Other work undertaken by the voluntary organisation include the installation of new litter bins, the design of a village motif and creation of a Farncombe village sign, bulb planting and litter picking days. With further projects already in the pipeline, residents and businesses are urged to get involved and make their voice heard by attending the Farncombe Initiative meetings.
