# 7. BUDGET MONITORING

Members to consider the attached budget monitoring report to 31 August 2017. Members are asked to note the following points:

- Rates due to the Valuation Office revaluing both cemeteries significantly (Eashing's rateable value went from £8,000 to £19,250 and Nightingale's from £385 to £2,850), the Burial Committee has overspent its Rates budget by £2,800 at Eashing. Nightingale was subject to some rates relief, which means there is no overspend this financial year but rates will need to be increased for the 2017/18 financial year.
- Grounds Maintenance £5,450 of Tree Safety Works has been done, which is putting some pressure on the Grounds Maintenance budget. There is an Earmarked Reserve for Tree Works, currently with a balance of £5,000. Officers will continue to monitor the revenue budget and report further at revised estimates.

Members to note that due to the improvement works carried out on Nightingale Chapel last financial year, the Earmarked Reserve for Chapels is currently a negative balance. Officers recommend that this be addressed by the following transfers:

- Eliminate the Consolidated Stock reserve of £4,506
- Reduce the Boundaries Reserve by £4,500 to £20,000
- Transfer the balance required of £40,994 from General Reserves, leaving a working balance of £36,772 which is 57% the Godalming Joint Burial Committee's precept.

Members to approve the recommended transfers.

## 8. NON-DOMESTIC RATES

Members will be aware the Government conducted an extensive change to the system of Non-Domestic Rates which came into effect on 1 April 2017. This coincided with the 5-yearly re-evaluation by the Valuation Office Agency (VOA) of the rateable value of all premises.

The resulting outcome of this process is that the rateable value of the cemeteries has increased.

- Nightingale Cemetery's rateable value has increased from £385 to £2,850 an increase of 740%. However, due to small business relief, which is allowable for rateable values below £12,000, the actual increase in the amount payable was only 7% from a payment of £186.34 to £199.57 (the amount payable is the rateable value in £s x the multiple factor i.e. an amount in every pound).
- Eashing Cemetery's rateable value has increased from £8,000 to £19,250 an increase
  of 241%. However, in the case of Eashing Cemetery the increase in the rateable value
  has taken it out of the Small Business relief bracket, therefore, the amount payable has
  increased from £1,290.66 in 2016/17 to £4,149.99 in 2017/18.

The Acting Clerk and Acting RFO have been unable to find any correspondence informing of this increase prior to the arrival of the invoice for payment. As previously outlined in the monitoring report, the level of increase experienced at Eashing Cemetery was not allowed for in the current budget and based on our current interment rates, £80 of each interment fee would be required to cover the increase.

Officers have obtained the detailed valuation for each of the cemeteries (attached for Members' information), however, Officers do not have the detailed knowledge required to be able to challenge the validity of the re-valuation. Therefore, if Members are minded to challenge the basis of the re-valuation of the cemeteries, Officers recommend that an appropriate solicitor or member of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors be engaged to conduct the 'Check, Challenge Appeal' process required to amend, if successful, the rateable value. If Members wish to mount a challenge the deadline for doing so is 30 November 2017.

# 9. BINDING OF MINUTES

Godalming Joint Burial Committee has a duty to maintain the minutes of its meetings as a permanent, publicly accessible record in a paper form. Currently 8 years' of committee minutes require binding into appropriate volumes; the cost of which is £105.00 plus VAT per volume. Although several years minutes are bound into each volume, the exact requirement will not be known until the binders (Shaw & Sons) receive the minute papers but is anticipated to require two volumes.

Members are requested to resolve the approval of expenditure of up to £210 plus VAT for the binding of the outstanding minutes. The cost to be met by Cost Centre 410/4900 (Miscellaneous Expenses).

# 10. BURIAL STATISTICS

Statistics for the previous quarter and the current quarter to date 8 September plus those for the twelve months ending 31 March 2017 are attached for the information of Members.
