## 6. <u>INCREASE IN CAR PARKING CHARGES</u>

Members are asked to consider proposals from Waverley Borough Council to increase car parking charges across the Borough and in particular the impact of those increases on car park charges in Godalming.

Attached for the information of Members is a page extracted from Waverley Borough Council's budgets papers considered by its Joint Overview & Scrutiny Committee on 16 January 2017. The page contains the summary of the proposals and those parts relevant to Godalming are highlighted.

The proposed increases in charges for Godalming car parks range from 11%, being the increase in the cost of the first hour's parking from 90p to £1 for South Street, Mint Street & Mill Lane car parks, to 100% being the increase in the cost of all day parking at Meadrow car park from £2 to £4. The increase in charge for the first hour at Crown Court car park is proposed as from 70p to £1, a rise of 43%, and an increase of 66% for the first three hours car parking at Crown Court (£2 to £3).

Members are asked to indicate whether they would wish to make representations to Waverley Borough Council about the increases proposed.
