6. CARBON REDUCTION & BIODIVERSITY FUND – ITEM FOR NOTE

Members will wish to note that with the new financial year the Carbon Reduction & Biodiversity Fund now stands at £10,000.

In its first year, which coincided with the challenges imposed by the national lockdowns, £8,400 was allocated to three projects, Loseley Fields School and Roots for the Future tree planting and environmental education program, the Godalming Nappy Library and the Godalming Cycle Campaign.

In regards to the Godalming Cycle Campaign, the grant of £3,000 was to facilitate a feasibility Study of the Cross Godalming Section of the Guildford to Godalming Greenway. Members will wish to note that from the feasibility study facilitated by the GTC grant, the Cycle campaign were successful in a £200,000 bid for Strategic Community Infrastructure Levy Funding in support of this project. Members will also wish to note that the feasibility study considered options for linking the route to the town and considered contra-flow cycling, for example along Moss Lane, to be a suitable and acceptable option. In summary, the report recommends that the better option would be to develop a route along The Buryes and that the

use of The Burys would also make it easier in the future to link the route directly to the town centre than going via the river.
