6. SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL – BOROUGH OF WAVERLEY - PROPOSED PROHIBITION ON HEAVY COMMERCIAL VEHICLES THE MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT OF WHICH EXCEEDS 7.5 TONNES FROM ENTERING OR PROCEEDING IN PART OF PRIMROSE RIDGE (D5425), GODALMING

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE "The Surrey County Council Primrose Ridge (D5425) Godalming (Weight Restriction) Order 201-" under Sections 1(1) and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers the purpose and effect of which is to prohibit any heavy commercial vehicle the maximum gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes from entering or proceeding along that length of Primrose Ridge (D5425), Godalming that extends from its junction with Portsmouth Road (A3100) to its junction with Hawthorn Road (D5425) (hereinafter referred to as "the restricted road").

The prohibition referred to above will not apply in respect of anything done:-

- (a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a traffic warden;
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway by or on behalf of the Surrey Police.

The prohibition referred to above will also not apply:-

- (a) to any person causing any vehicle to enter the restricted road for the purpose of gaining access to or of leaving any land or property situated on or adjacent to this road or accessible only from this road;
- (b) in relation to any vehicle when used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority;
- (c) in relation to any vehicle being used in connection with the maintenance, improvement, reconstruction, cleansing or lighting of the restricted road or any road accessible only from the restricted road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer under the restricted road or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communication apparatus provided under the Telecommunications Act 1984 and the Communications Act 2003 situated under or on the restricted road, or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign on the restricted road;
- (d) to vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes;
- (e) in relation to any vehicle being used in connection with the carrying out on land or any property situated on or adjacent to the restricted road of any building, industrial or demolition operation or the removal of any obstruction to traffic; and
- (f) in relation to any vehicle being used for the purposes of agriculture on any land situated adjacent to the restricted road or for, or in connection with, the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land.

7. <u>TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 2017 – MINT STREET (D5421), GODALMING</u>

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to:

- a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Mint Street (D5421), Godalming that extends from the eastern property boundary of No.11 Church Street (D5403) to the western property boundary of No.2 Mint Street (D5421); and

STATEMENT OF REASONS


For a number of years local residents have expressed concerns about the environmental impact of HGV traffic using Primrose Ridge as a 'rat-run' between A3100 Portsmouth Road and D5425 Ockford Ridge via D5425 Hawthorn Road and D5425 Miltons Crescent.

In response to these concerns Surrey County Council are promoting the above draft Order on environmental grounds, following an assessment of Primrose Ridge that considered factors such as traffic data, the availability of an alternative route, the road and footway widths, and in particular the steepness of the ridge.

Surrey County Council approved funding for the proposed scheme at the Committee Meeting held on 11 December 2015. This can be found in the 11 December Committee Report under section Highway Budgets for 2016/17 Annex A, Summary of 4 Area Prioritisation.

Following an analysis of existing speeds and consultation with Surrey Police it is proposed to impose a 7.5 Tonne Heavy Goods Vehicle Restriction.

It is proposed to implement the new 7.5 tonnes weight restriction on part of Primrose Ridge starting from the A3100 Portsmouth Road junction with D5425 Primrose Ridge to junction of D5425 Hawthorn Road.

OBJECTION TO TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS

- 1. The objection period for a Traffic Regulation Order will run for one calendar month unless a shorter period is specified in the public advertisement (e.g. 20 April 1996 to 19 May 1996) and all valid objections received during that period will be considered.
- 2. Objections will be accepted up to 3 days after the end of the objection period to allow for postal delays, provided they are dated and posted within the objection period. If an objection letter is undated or dated after the end of the objection period it will not be accepted as a formal objection.
- 3. If objectors wish to write further or submit further evidence they may do so provided that they:-
 - (a) Write and object to the proposals during the objection period;
 - (b) In their correspondence clearly state that they will be submitting further representations and the type of representation that they will be submitting. If an objector requests permission to submit a letter and then produces a petition this will not be accepted.
- 4. If objectors wish to submit a petition they may do so at any time during the objection period. If they wish to submit a petition outside the objection period they must indicate in writing during the objection period and state that their petition will be submitted outside the objection period.
- 5. County Council officers may, if they consider it necessary, impose a further deadline by which additional representations or petitions must be sent to the County Council.
- 6. Objectors may withdraw their objections at any time by written instruction. However, once an objector has withdrawn the objection by written instruction that objection may not be revived at a later date.
