#### 497. INSURANCE REVIEW

Members considered a report from Councillor Heagin on the review of the Council's insurance for 2021/22 and beyond.

Members noted that although several providers were approached initially (as required by Financial Regulation 10.3), when it became obvious through correspondence that a provider would not be able to better the terms and costs of our existing provider, no formal quotation was sought. This was done in order to preserve the Council's reputation within the industry.

# 498. COUNCIL BANKING ARRANGEMENTS

Members agreed that the following criteria should be considered in evaluating banking institutions for the Council:

- Moody's/Fitch's or S&P's rating per Treasury & Investment Policy
- High Street presence and length of time in Godalming
   – our community needs High
   Street banks and those that continue to operate in our town are deserving of our
   support. This is also consistent with the Council's Godalming First ethos;
- ease of administration of the Council's day-to-day banking needs;
- financial security are they covered by FSCS?
- Fees/charges and interest payable on deposits;
- ethical credentials:
- service quality; and
- cost/disruption of making any change for example, is all ID checking online, or is physical attendance necessary by all signatories?

The Responsible Finance Officer to evaluate the following banking institutions against the above criteria and report back to this Committee at its meeting in July:

- HSBC
- Lloyd's
- NatWest
- Triodos
- Handelsbanken
- The Co-Operative
