7. <u>TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER (NO. 3) 2012 – HOLLOWAY HILL</u> (D169)

THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Holloway Hill (D169), Godalming that extends from its junction with Ockford Road to its junction with Braemar Close.

This Temporary Traffic Order is required to facilitate The Surrey County Council to carry out major highway maintenance and surface treatment. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 09:30 and 16:30 within the twelve-month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on 24 September 2012. Advance warning detailing the precise dates for works will be displayed. The temporary closures and restrictions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed and will not all operate simultaneously. Access will be maintained for pedestrians, residents and emergency vehicles.

Alternative Route: Holloway Hill (D169), Godalming, vehicular traffic will be diverted via Ockford Road (A3100), Shackstead Lane (D5404) and Tuesley Lane (D169).
