7. SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2012 -  
SPRING GROVE (D5410) FARNCOMBE

Members to note that on the 5 December 2012 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Spring Grove (D5410), Farncombe that extends from its junction with Green Lane to its junction with Loseley Road and/or any part and/or parts therein.

The Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to carry out major maintenance and resurfacing works. These works are anticipated to be carried out within one week of the six-month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on the 7 December 2012. Works are scheduled to commence later next week and will be carried out between the hours of 09:00 and 16:30. The closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access will be maintained for pedestrians, residents and emergency vehicles at all times. Traffic will be diverted via Green Lane, Barnes Road and Loseley Road.

8. SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2012 –  
BRIGHTON ROAD (B2130) AND SALT LANE (C32), GODALMING

Members to note that Surrey County Council propose to make the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of:

a) Brighton Road (B2130), Godalming that extends from its junction with Croft Road to its junction with Home Farm Road and/or any part and/or parts therein.

b) Salt Lane (C32), Godalming that extends from its junction with Clock Barn Lane to its junction with New Road and/or any part and/or parts therein.

The Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable works on behalf of British Telecom. These works are anticipated to be carried out as within thirteen days of the three-month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on the 7 January 2013. The closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access will be maintained for pedestrians, residents and emergency vehicles at all times.

For part a) works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 09:30 to 15:30, within

ten days (weekdays only) from the 7 January 2013. Vehicular traffic will be diverted via Flambard Way, Holloway Hill, Tuesley Way, Quarter Mile Road and Home Farm Road.

For part b) works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 09:30 to 15:30, within three days from the 16 January 2013. Vehicular traffic will be diverted via Clock Barn Lane, Hambledon Road and Salt Lane.

9. SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2012 – AARONS HILL (D5424), GODALMING

Members to note that Surrey County Council propose to make the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of:

Aarons Hill (D5424), Godalming that extends from its junction with Bargate Rise to a point opposite the southernmost property line of No. 10 Aarons Hill and/or any part and/or parts therein.

The Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable local structural repair works. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as is possible within one week of the twelve-month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on the 2 January 2013. The closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access will be maintained for pedestrians, residents and emergency vehicles at all times.

There is no diversion route due to the road being a cul-de-sac.
