Additionally, it enhances their self-esteem and provides experience of the real world of work. Skillway has benefitted from the marvellous donation of the profits for the evening, which raised £560 but which was supplemented by Sainsbury's and a cheque for £1,000 was very gratefully received by the CEO of Skillway from staff representatives of Sainsbury's Godalming.
