Although Godalming Town Council has no direct responsibility for economic development or business support and receives no funding from the business rates, the past year has demonstrated the importance of a local council in supporting its retail centre. Please be assured that the action plan at section three is being actively worked on and that Godalming Town Council is also working in partnership with Waverley Borough Council economic development team.

It is also important that we look at what is positive within our town (without denying that there are always things that need improving). Although during the pandemic the vacancy rate within the central area rose from just over 5% to nearly 11% a number of the vacant units are under negotiation for new tenants.
