Staycation activities are mostly free or at a specially discounted Staycation price, with the added bonus that they are all really close to home so you don't have to worry about expensive travelling costs.

Godalming Town Council is pleased to welcome back regular favourites such as canoeing, tennis, swimming, fishing, bowling, brass band taster sessions, ballerina workshops, football, including the chance to play on Godalming Town Football Club's pitch, cricket, walks, flower arranging demonstration and ukulele lessons. As a special event this year we have Patrick Haveron's 'Fat Dads' Mountain bike ride with a stop off at the pub afterwards and Godalming Cycle Campaign's Family Friendly Cycle Ride.

Exciting new activities for 2018 including an introduction to authentic Tai Chi and Qui Gong down by the river. Bring the children to a creative writing workshop or one of the street dance sessions and the grown-ups can enjoy a free Rock Choir singing experience. If you or your children have always wanted to learn to play bridge and other card games then try your hand during Staycation. On Thursday 9 August there's a chance for grandparents, senior friends, relatives and youngsters to enjoy some interactive inter-generational time with a Virtual Reality short film and a chance to meet a local resident who'll be sharing her war time experiences. The second of our intergenerational events is a drop-in work shop to learn how to become a Tree Guardian with Roots for the Future.

Staycation week begins on Saturday, 4 August with the TST Staycation Live Music Festival at the Bandstand. On Saturday, 11 August, Godalming Town Council's "DOGALMING" will be taking place at Aarons Hill Recreation Ground between 12 – 4.00pm. Bring your four-legged best friend







and enter into the fun. Categories include Best Puppy, Best Family Dog, Best Dressed, Best Veteran and Best in Show. Entries are on the day with prizes kindly donated by Nestlé Purina. Canine Partners will demonstrate with Warwick the dog what their amazing charity does to help transform the lives of people with physical disabilities. There will also be a family fete with fun side shows, Punch & Judy, hog roast, face-painting, tea tent and more.
