TOWN MAYOR'S AWARD VOLUNTEERS 2019

The Mayor of Godalming, Councillor Nick Williams is seeking nominations for the Mayor's Award for Volunteers for 2019. This award recognises local people who volunteer their time and skills in Godalming and Farncombe for the benefit of the community and the town.

Since its inception in 2005 over seventy people have received a Mayor's award. Councillor Williams said about the Mayor's Awards "the opportunity to recognise those who give of their time, which ensures that people in our community have much needed support and care, is one of the highlights of a Mayor's year. As well as being a privilege for me, as Mayor, it is also a wonderful opportunity for the Town Council to be able to express its appreciation and to be able to recognise and present awards to volunteers. However, I can only do so with the help of others – family, friends, fellow volunteers or beneficiaries, which is why I am asking for nominations for this year's awards."

Successful recipients of the award will be presented with a framed certificate and a small token of gratitude. These will be presented at the Annual Town Meeting on Thursday, 18 April 2019 at 8.00pm in the Council Chamber and their names will be displayed on the town's honours board.
