Children will be also be able to enjoy free pony rides and say hello to Dexter, Merla and friends in Church Street and ride the Dobby Horse Carousel in Crown Court. Santa's Grotto will be at the Wilfrid Noyce Centre thanks to the Godalming & District Chamber of Commerce assisted by Downs Solicitors and the Godalming Food Company. They will be joined by Moss Lane School who will be laying on Christmas themed craft activities and The Meath will be providing delicious cakes and welcome refreshments.

There is a full programme of entertainment at The Pepperpot and opening the proceedings will be Moss Lane School's choir who delighted the crowds last year followed by the Godalming Theatre Group who will be making a special guest appearance.
