## PADDLE POWER FOR GODALMING DISTRICT SCOUT CANOE CLUB

Earlier this year, the Godalming District Scout Canoe Club applied to the Town Council for a grant from its Council Community Fund to enable the club to replace its paddles. The club was awarded a grant of £500 to purchase new paddles which have a more ergonomic and efficient design which will help their young paddlers to develop their technique, confidence and to use equipment similar to that used by their coaches to enable more effective coaching.
