6. <u>TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2014 - (C23) CHALK ROAD, GODALMING</u>

SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL PROPOSE TO MAKE the above mentioned Order under Section 14(1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act ("The Act") 1984, the effect of which will be to:-

- (a) Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding along the length of (C23) Chalk Road, Godalming, between the western boundary of property number 30A Chalk Lane and the railway bridge, a distance of 30 metres.
- (b) Revoke in its entirety the "Surrey County Council (C23) Chalk Road Godalming Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2013".

The Order is required to enable Morrisons access to carry out utility works. These works are anticipated to be carried out over two days between 08.00hrs on the 8th March 2014 and 16.00hrs on the 9th March 2014 with back up dates of between 08.00hrs on the 15th March 2014 and 16.00hrs on the 16th March 2014 if necessary within the one-month period of operation of this Order which commences on 8th March 2014. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed but it is anticipated that the road will remain closed between these times. Access will be maintained for pedestrians at all times. Residents and emergency vehicles will have access via the signed diversion route.

Vehicular traffic will be diverted via Borough Road, Church Street, High Street, Flambard Way, Wharf Street and Bridge Road.
