Remembrance Sunday – 13 November 2016

This year, Remembrance Sunday falls on the 13 November. Uniformed organisations, veterans and Town Councillors will parade to the Phillips Memorial ground by the War Memorial to join residents of Godalming who gather there at 10.50am for the Act of Remembrance; this will be followed by a Service of Remembrance in the Parish Church of St Peter & St Paul at 11.15 am. Anyone wishing to join the parade should be at Waverley Borough Council's offices car park at The Burys, Godalming at 10.15am, ready to step off at 10.20am.

After the church service, the Parade will return down the High Street and then, instead of the previous route, will turn down Great George Street back to The Burys. The Mayor will take the Salute outside the Pepperpot at the top of the High Street.

During the two weeks prior to Remembrance Sunday, there will be a public collection organised by the Royal British Legion. We ask your readers to support this most generously in order that the Legion may continue not only to help those who have been permanently disabled by war but also their families when necessary. As is the custom in Godalming, Town Councillors will help with this collection at Sainsbury's Godalming on Saturday, 12 November from 9.00 am until 4.00 pm.
