8. <u>WAVERLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL CONSULTATION - DRAFT OCKFORD ROAD CONSERVATION AREA APPRAISAL DOCUMENT</u>

Members to consider the Draft Ockford Road Conservation Area Appraisal (CAA) document – hard copy attached for the information of Members or available on Waverley Borough Council's website at www.waverley.gov.uk/ockfordroadcaa

The document is currently out for consultation (consultation period from 13 March 2015 to 24 April 2015) and the Appraisal recommends amendments to the Conservation Area boundary. Specifically a significant extension of the Conservation Area (CA) is proposed along Ockford Road towards the town centre (as described in pages 24 & 25 of the CAA document) as is an extension of the CA boundary to include the full garden area of the Inn on the Lake (see page 26 of the CAA document).

10. <u>TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC ORDER 2015 - (D98) BOURNE ROAD, FARNCOMBE</u>

Members to note that Surrey County Council proposes to make the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of (D98) Bourne Road, Farncombe, comprising of the railway crossing and 10 metres either side, a total distance of 30 metres.

This Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable Centurion to carry out urgent barrier maintenance work on behalf of Network Rail. These works are anticipated to be carried out over one night between the hours of 00.01hrs and 05.00hrs on the 21st April 2015 within the one-week period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order that commences on 21st April 2015. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access will be maintained for pedestrians and emergency vehicles at all times. Access will be maintained for residents via the signed diversion route.

Vehicular traffic will be diverted via Bourne Road, Farncombe Street, Station Road and Bourne Road.
