Godalming Town Council is delighted, that it has taken another step on its journey, to ensure that as many of its services as possible are provided in a dementia friendly environment.

As part of the Council's improvement programme for its publicly owned facilities, the refurbishment of the public conveniences in Crown Court, Godalming has not only resulted in better energy and water efficient facilities, but also provides a more pleasant and hygienic environment that incorporates dementia friendly colour schemes and signage as well as step free access.

With the support of The Peter Caudle Memorial Trust, the Town Council's planned refurbishment of the internal areas of the iconic Pepperpot building is also well underway, and to complete a busy start to 2019, the refurbishment of the Local History Gallery at Godalming Museum is also nearing completion. The Museum project is being overseen by the ever resourceful, 92 year old John Young, who has been managing projects at the museum for over 35 years, John is a Freeman of Godalming.

These projects support Godalming Town Council's aim of 'Supporting Our Community' by maintaining, improving and enhancing its service provision to the community.
