# 7. UPDATE ON THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Notes of the joint working group/steering group meeting held on 9 October 2015. This meeting was the subject of an oral update on 15 October 2015.

#### Questionnaire

At the time of writing 1,912 paper questionnaires have been received and 175 electronic responses. Of the paper questionnaires 760 have been transcribed & checked; a further 460 are transcribed and unchecked; 200 are "out" for transcription and 492 are as yet untouched. These figures will be updated orally at the meeting. Analysis cannot start until all have been transcribed and checked.

However, with a concerted push on processing over the next week (before the meeting) it is still hoped to be able to share the main highlights of the questionnaire findings with the volunteers at a social event to be held on 10 November 2015. The final report will be available at the meeting of this Committee to be held on 26 November.

## **Ad hoc Advisory Committee**

On 15 October 2015 the Policy & Management Committee agreed the changes to Standing Orders required to facilitate the formation of an ad hoc advisory Committee and recommended those changes to Full Council for adoption on 19 November 2015.

At the next meeting of this Committee on 26 November 2015 it should be possible formally to form the ad hoc advisory committee. At that meeting it will also be necessary to agree the meeting dates for the advisory committee to the end of the current civic year (those dates are given in the attached notes) with Full Council setting the dates for the civic year 2016/17.

# GTC NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN WORKING GROUP & GOFARNP STEERING GROUP MEETING

Held on Friday 9 October 2015 at 6.00pm at The Pepperpot

Welcome & Introductions: Kirsty Walden welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were made

Future arrangements for the Steering Group: Kirsty Walden outlined proposals formally to amalgamate the two groups (GTC's Councillor Working Group & the GOFARNP Steering Group) into an ad hoc advisory Committee of the Town Council's Planning & Environment Committee. The formal steps to effect that change would take place over a number of GTC meetings but the final one would be the meeting of the P&E Committee scheduled for 26 November 2015. All would be invited to be present at that meeting which would also receive a report on the findings of the questionnaire. The proposed dates for meetings of that advisory committee are given at the end of these notes.

**Redrafted Project Plan:** A redrafted project plan was considered and John Talbot pointed out that it did not make provision for stakeholder engagement, and at that point he distributed the considerable piece of work he had undertaken coordinating the numerous stakeholders identified and each working group's requirements in relation to which stakeholders they wished to consult with. Louise Goodfellow undertook to redraft the project plan to include stakeholder engagement (attached).

**Update on Questionnaire:** Louise Goodfellow gave an update on the number of questionnaires received to date (approx. 1650 being 1543 hard copy and 100 or so electronically). Louise outlined the onerous task of processing the questionnaires and indicated that help would be welcome, but that volunteers would need to be able to use Excel and have an eye for detail.

**Social Event for Volunteers 10 November 2015:** Louise Goodfellow outlined arrangements for a social event for volunteers to be held at The Wharf on Tuesday 10 November. Volunteers were to be invited to that event and to the P&E Committee meeting on 26 November 2015

How to engage with new "volunteers"?: Louise Goodfellow asked the meeting for a steer on how to engage with questionnaire respondents who had indicated that they would like to become involved in the Neighbourhood Plan process. It was agreed that all would be invited to the P&E meeting on 26 November and that Louise would work up a programme of focus groups to discuss in more detail some of the issues raised by the questionnaire (or other issues raised by groups). After 26 November potential volunteers

might be offered the opportunity to join one of the GOFARNP groups but that this would depend on whether a group felt it needed new input at this time – this definitely applied to the Community & Infrastructure Group.

**Issues/queries from each Working Group:** a roundtable item revealed that groups were in abeyance awaiting the results of the questionnaire
