8. <u>Central godalming development – Public Engagement – **Item for Decision**</u>

Recommendation: Members to resolve to appoint a 6-Member politically proportionate Task & Finish Group to formulate a draft response to the Central Godalming Development public engagement options. The draft to be submitted to the Town Clerk by Wednesday, 24 August to be considered by the Environment & Planning Committee on 1 September 2022.

Following previous presentations from WBC regarding the potential for development of the Central Godalming area, WBC have opened a public engagement exercise, running from 26 July to 6 September.

On 11 August Members of GTC are invited to view the information boards located in the reception area of The Burys council offices to assist in their considerations of the options put forward. A time slot between 5.30pm and 6.15pm being specifically designated for GTC Members. During this period, Waverley Officers will be available to take note of any individual comments and/or take/answer questions.

Following the opportunity to view the options, Members will have the chance to debate the Central Godalming Development public engagement process at the Environment & Planning Committee that will be held at 6.30pm on the same evening.

It is suggested that to reach a collective view to enable a formal response to be made from Godalming Town Council on this important development that a Task & Finish Group is formed whose task would be to consider Members' views and opinions relating to the options displayed on the 11 August and to produce a draft formal response letter setting out a collective position. The draft response would be considered by the Environment & Planning Committee on 1 September with the aim of reaching a collective view to be submitted as the formal response of Godalming Town Council. It should be noted that the formal response needs to be submitted to WBC by 16 September.

Whilst it is unlikely that the Task & Finish Group would be able to craft a response that is endorsed by all Members, it is important that the Town Council engages with the process and submits a representation that reflects the majority view of the Council and therefore the Town Council's collective position.
