The Godalming and Farncombe Neighbourhood Plan will guide planning in the locality for the next 15 years. Six teams are helping to prepare the plan. These teams cover: Community & Infrastructure, Economy, Environment, Heritage & Design, Housing, Transport.

The current consultation provides the opportunity for local groups and organisations to contribute to the plan. This survey is specifically about the Environment which includes the allocation and development of green space, the management of water and air quality. *Green space* is any area, small or large, formal or informal that is not built on. *Water* comprises all lakes, rivers and streams and how they are managed for wildlife and recreational potential and to alleviate the risk of flooding. *Air quality* relates to the control of pollution and the promotion of practices that contribute to clean air.
