

## GoFar Questionnaire

### Statistical Issues

There are significant issues once one analyses the disaggregated age-group data, which prospectively render unadjusted Overall Total responses misleading. (**Louise & Kirsten please note.**)

I have compared by Age Group the Respondents v-a-v the N O S Census data (see attachment) for GoFar.

Clearly when quoting any overall total figure or comment, the results need to be corrected so that each Age Group's number or opinion has a weighting corresponding to its share of GoFar's population; rather than being based upon the proportion of respondents. The

- 19 – 29 age group is under represented by a factor of well over 4 times
- 60 – 69 is over represented by a factor of over 50%, and the Over 70s by nearly 50%

Fortunately the number of respondents in each age group above age 19 is sufficient for their number to be statistically significant.

With the Housing Data there is an additional problem – common across all the age-groups – stemming from the way in which the question was worded, which resulted in each respondent specifying  $\pm 5$  units of accommodation! To compute a % analysis this factor needs to be removed. I have corrected the Housing Need data to reduce it to each respondent having one "vote", proportionately allocated in line with the questionnaire returns. This enables one to summarise the data on housing priorities by housing type so it sums to a 100%. (See attached spreadsheet – both a printed version and also the excel spreadsheet itself, for those who wish to interrogate the data for themselves)

Based on the Respondent proportions we have:

However this needs to be re-weighted to correspond to the ONS Census proportions. Unfortunately the GoFar Questionnaire has used different age breaks to the ONS data, so I have set out in an attachment how I have transformed the ONS data into GoFar's age groups.

Once it is weighted using the ONS population proportions, the housing needs are affected as follows:

Because with the housing question, respondents were asked what their views of GoFar's housing needs were, as opposed to many other questions which were seeking respondents' own views; with the housing data there is surprisingly little difference when one corrects for the actual population weightings.

That said, one should note a 7½% overstatement of the need for social housing.

This is due to 46.5% of the over 70s, against only 27.3% of the under 29s being concerned about the lack of social housing. It would be interesting to learn from Focus Groups whether the greater concern among older residents about the lack of social housing reflects:

- their concern about their offspring's housing prospects;
- a longing to see adult children actually fly the nest; or
- a feeling of themselves being trapped in a council house with little prospect of single floor living in either a bungalow or some form of sheltered accommodation.

As there seems to be nothing in the Questionnaire that contradicts the housing priorities we had previously identified, I will now incorporate this Questionnaire information into the Housing Evidence document and re-circulate that before Christmas.
