GODALMING TOWN COUNCIL SERVICES

Godalming Town Council provides a range of services to the town's residents including its flagship town centre venue the Wilfrid Novce Centre. Broadwater Park Community Centre in Farncombe and the town's iconic Pepperpot.

It also funds the Godalming Museum, public toilets in Godalming and Farncombe, two cemeteries, sixteen acres of allotment sites, Floral Godalming flower displays in the town centre, Christmas Lights in Farncombe and Godalming retail centres and a range of festivals and markets.

The Council also runs the Staycation holiday programme, the fireworks display and annual Remembrance Parade and assists in the management of the monthly Farmers' Markets.

As well as supporting the Godalming Dementia Action Alliance, the Town Council also supports many events run by community organisations such as the St John's Spring Fair, Sport Godalming's Community Run, the Round Table's Town Show. Stavcation Live Music Festival and Churches Together's Town Day, all of which help make Godalming such a vibrant community.



GODALMING TOWN COUNCIL'S GRANTS BUDGET INCREASED FOR 2019

The Town Council makes many grants to the town's voluntary organisations - which for 2019/20 will be increased to £60,000, a sum significantly larger than many other areas in Waverley.

For many organisations, such as the Citizen's Advice Waverley and the Waverley Hoppa Community Transport service, support from Godalming Town Council is a vital lifeline for them to be able to continue to provide invaluable services to local residents. Godalming Town Council has three levels of grant funding for organisations and community groups.

GODALMING TOWN COUNCIL'S CONTINUING INVESTMENT FOR 2019

The Town Council continues its recent history of investment in the town.

Plans to refurbish the Godalming public toilets and The Pepperpot meeting room are, at the time of going to press, underway together with improvement works to the Godalming Museum and facilities at Broadwater Park Community Centre.

Godalming Town Council believes these projects demonstrate that it is meeting its aim of 'Supporting Our Community' by providing the best service possible within the available resources.

The council is fulfilling its statutory duties and obligations, whilst also maintaining, improving and enhancing its service provision to the community.

GODALMING COUNCIL TAX

Despite the Retail Price Index reaching 3.3% in October 2018, in January, Godalming Town Council unanimously agreed that the Council would only need to increase its share of the Council Tax bill for 2019/20 by 1.98%.

This equates to an increase of just over 2.6 pence per week for a Band D property.

PROPOSED ADDITIONS TO BOROUGH'S INFRASTRUCTURE DELIVERY PLAN

Waverley Borough Council's Infrastructure Delivery Plan sets out to identify what infrastructure is needed in each of the Borough areas. The existing infrastructure plan includes a number of projects which could be supported by the Town Council's portion of funds from the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL).

CIL funding is provided by developers to support the infrastructure improvements required in an expanding community. The projects already identified in the current plan are:

- the Meadrow Flood Alleviation scheme;
- skate park at Farncombe (Broadwater Park);
- integration of bus network with train services; and
- · Guildford-Godalming Greenway.

Following a review, Godalming Town Council has asked that Waverley Borough Council look at adding the following potential projects to the Infrastructure Delivery Plan:

- provision of pedestrian crossing facilities at Meadrow (by Godalming Junior School);
- increased parking facilities at both Godalming and Farncombe train stations;
- environmental and leisure improvements to 'Charterhouse Green';
- re-instatement of the 'Horse Bridge' from Godalming Wharf to the Lammas Land;
- tow path improvements on the Godalming section of the Godalming & Wey Navigation;
- provision of new community centres/increasing capacity within existing facilities;
- on street Electric Vehicle Charging Points (EVP) (i.e. adaption of lamp posts to allow paid for EVP); and

• improvements of existing play provision to allow wheelchair and pushchair access across grassed areas.

Although at this stage project costs and the delivery phase are unknown and further works will be required to prioritise the delivery of potential projects, the sources of funding for projects put forward by the Town Council would be CIL/other funding (other funding could be from external grants or from partnership working with other agencies).
