# **Public Consultation on options for a Godalming Flood Alleviation Scheme**

Along with our partners from the Environment Agency, Surrey Council, Waverley Borough Council and others including local residents we've been looking at plans for a flood alleviation for Godalming.

A public meeting, chaired by the Rt Hon Jeremy Hunt MP, will be held on Thursday 21 January 2016 at 7pm in the Borough Hall (doors open at 6.30pm) to present the preferred options. Please come along to have your say.

Sandbags - Waverley Borough Council's contractor for distribution of sandbags is Veolia who will distribute sandbags in areas of highest priority first dependent on their resources at the time. You can contact Veolia on 01252 724157 during office hours. Out of hours please contact Southern Monitoring Service on 02392 242161.

Trees - Report trees blocking roads and pavements to Surrey County Council on 03456 009 009.

Water/Sewerage - For issues with water supply, please contact the supplier you pay your bills to. In Godalming this is most likely to be Thames Water on **0845 920 0800**.

Electricity - To report a potential hazard on or near overhead electricity lines call National Grid on **0800 404090**.

To report power cuts contact your supplier which for the Godalming area is either Scottish and Southern Energy **0800 072 7282** or UK Power Networks **0800 783 8866**.

Gas - To report a potential gas leak call National Grid on 0800 111 999.
