GRANTS GIVEN BY GODALMING TOWN COUNCIL

Godalming Town Council recently agreed nearly £13,000 worth of grants to community organisations bringing the total grants allocated so far this financial year to £42,000.

Six organisations were helped in the most recent award of grants. £5,000 was given to “Our Community Street Team” towards the cost of buying a mobile youth provision to be used in Farncombe. A further £5,000 was awarded to Waverley Hoppa Community Transport to assist with providing “Hospital Hoppa” a door-to-door non-emergency patient transport service taking Godalming residents to the Royal Surrey County Hospital and other local health facilities. Churches Together in Godalming & District was awarded £500 to help fund entertainment, refreshments and publicity for “Christmas Together in Godalming” an all day event to be held on 4 December 2010. On the same day ClassAction Theatre, the performance company of sixth formers at Godalming College will perform the Godalming Nativity a processional nativity play on the town centre’s streets and £1,048 was granted to assist with the staging of this performance. Finally Godalming District Scout Canoe Club received £500 and The Godalming Trust £621.

Councillor Steve Cosser, Chairman of the Policy & Management Committee said, “We are fortunate in Godalming in having many groups who give very generously of their time to enrich our community life. In difficult financial times it is important that we continue to support these groups.”
