6. NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING

7. TEMPORARY TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER 2013 – FLAMBARD WAY (A3100) AND BRIGHTON ROAD (B2130), GODALMING

THE SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of this Order will be to: -

a) Temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from driving along Flambard Way (A3100), Godalming that extends from its junction with Woolsack Way (D5419) to a point 50 metres west of its junction with Brighton Road (B2130) in excess of 10 MPH when convoy work is operational.

b) Temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from driving along that length of Flambard Way (A3100), Godalming that extends from its junction with Bridge Road (A3100) eastwards to its junction with Woolsack Way (D5419) from driving in excess of 20 MPH when convoy work is operational.

c) Temporarily prohibit vehicular traffic from driving along that length of Flambard Way (A3100), Godalming that extends from its junction with Queen Street (D5427), westwards to a point 50 metres west of its junction with Brighton Road (B2130) from driving in excess of 20 MPH when convoy work is operational.

d) Temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding on that length of Brighton Road (B2130), Godalming that extends from its junction with Flambard Way (A3100) to its junction with Munstead Heath Road (C31) and/or any part and/or parts therein.

This Temporary Traffic Order is required to enable major carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works. These works are anticipated to be carried out within four weeks of the twelve-month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on 1st July 2013. The prohibitions referred to in part a), part b) and part c) above shall not operate simultaneously with the prohibition described in part d) and none shall apply except during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs. Access will be maintained for pedestrians, emergency vehicles and residents at all times.

For part d) traffic will be diverted via Flambard Way (A3100), Ockford Road (A3100), Shackstead Lane (D5404), Tuesley Lane (D169), Quatermile Road (D5407) and Home Farm Road (D5407).
