Often seen walking his four long-haired dachshunds together in Godalming's town centre or carrying several suits to and from the dry cleaners, Anthony was familiar to many of the town's residents. For twenty-one years he met the gentlemen of Godalming's need for formalwear whether for a wedding, formal dinner or school prom.

Anthony is remembered fondly by other traders as an ardent monarchist and as a good friend. He will be much missed.
