Community Benefits from Godalming Town Council Grants

On 12 July 2018 Godalming Town Council awarded grants to organisations who provide benefits to the Godalming community.

During the current round of grant awards, the main beneficiaries were The Godalming Good Neighbour Scheme who received a grant to assist with the setting up of the scheme in the Godalming area. The Godalming Good Neighbour Scheme wishes to engage volunteers who will be able to assist older and vulnerable people to get out and about. The Cellar Café received a grant to allow the Cellar Café to provide coach trips to the coast for Cellar customers, their families and individuals who cannot afford a holiday or a day out. 'Safe Drive, Stay Alive' received a grant to assist with running the 'Safe Drive, Stay Alive' performances which is a road safety initiative aiming to highlight to all young people, their responsibilities whilst being in a car as a driver or passenger and the Waverley free fun Skating/BMX and scootering event for young people aged 7-18 in Godalming also received a grant to help facilitate this event which will be held on Friday 10 August, 10-4pm at Aarons Hill Skate Park.

Since April 2018, Godalming Town Council has awarded a total of £48,953.00 to assist with local good causes.
