COMMUNITY BENEFITS FROM GODALMING TOWN COUNCIL GRANTS

Godalming Town Council is pleased to announce that from the Council's grant budget of £58,000.00, funds totalling £51,741.00 have been awarded so far this current year to groups who provide benefits to the Godalming community.

During the current round of grant awards, the main beneficiaries were: The Baden Hall Management Trust for a replacement heating system in their hall which will benefit the Rainbows, Beavers, Cubs and Brownies along with the Scouts and Guides who all use this much loved hall. Home Start in Waverley were also awarded a grant from the General Grants Fund to assist in training volunteers.

A Council Community Grant was given to support a Dementia Friendly matinee screening of the Christmas favourite "It's a Wonderful Life" at the Wilfrid Noyce Centre on Saturday,15 December. Visiting a cinema is one of life's pleasures, which most people take for granted. With Dementia being one of the greatest challenges facing our society today, it is a sad fact that many people affected by dementia often have to give up things they love due to inaccessibility and unsupportive environments.
