Have your say on the Godalming & Farncombe Neighbourhood Plan

A referendum is due to be held on the Godalming & Farncombe Neighbourhood Plan on Tuesday, 9 July 2019. The Neighbourhood Plan area is the same as the Godalming Town Council boundary within the Waverley Borough Council Local Planning Authority area. Only residents of Godalming & Farncombe are eligible to vote. The aim of the Godalming & Farncombe Neighbourhood Plan is to:

- protect our environment;
- support our local shops and businesses;
- provide housing needed for a sustainable community;
- provide safe pedestrian and cycle links;
- safeguard air quality;
- improve play facilities; and
- ensure more CIL funds* are available for local infrastructure.

*A majority Yes Vote for the Neighbourhood Plan on 9 July will increase the available Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) for use by the Godalming & Farncombe community from 15 to 25% of a Developer's CIL contribution.
