## **TOWN COUNCIL SEALS COMMUNITY MEALS**

Since the town went into lockdown, Farncombe Day Centre has been supporting the community by delivering a freshly prepared, hot two-course meal to those who need them.

The Centre's mini bus and Godalming Town Council's works van are delivering meals in the Farncombe and Godalming area and have even delivered as far afield as Chiddingfold. To help the Centre's Community Meals' Scheme increase the numbers it can assist, Godalming Town provided £2,500 for the purchase of a heat sealing machine, which ensures meals arrive as fresh as when they left the Day Centre's kitchen.

Annette Clarke, Farncombe Day Centre Manager said "we are currently delivering between 30 and 40 hot meals a day and the sealing machine is a vital part of being able to deliver to as many people as we can."
