8. <u>PRIMARY RETAIL AREA INFRASTRUCTURE TRANSPORT SCHEME - ITEM FOR DECISION</u>

Recommendation: Members to resolve to agree that Officers seek proposals and costings from appropriate consultants to meet the aims of the Motion on Notice recorded at Min No 479-21 and prepare a funding report for Members' consideration.

On 10 March 2022, Members resolved to pass a Motion on Notice that, in short, sought to:

- Create a 20mph zone within the Godalming Primary Shopping Area.
- Create a partial Prohibition of Entry into Godalming High Street.
- Create designated loading and unloading bay(s) and Blue Badge Holder disabled bays within Godalming town centre.
- Allow for contra-flow cycling along the length of Godalming High Street and the provision of appropriate information signage.
- Allow for contra-flow cycling along the length of Bridge Street and the provision of appropriate signage.

- Allow for contra-flow cycling along the length of Church Street and the provision of appropriate signage.
- The painting of double yellow lines with provision for loading by way of kerb marking yellow lines on the south side of Godalming High Street between its junction with Wharf Street and Queen Street.
- The painting of double yellow lines with provision for loading by way of kerb markings in the layby on the north side of High Street outside No 6.

In pursuant of the Motion (Min No 479-21 refers) the Town Clerk contacted SCC who responded on 5 May 2022 with the following information:

"Local Committee no longer makes decisions on Highways.

The Highways team receive many requests from Parish and Town Councils, and if these are supported by the County Member they will try to assist in delivery if they are funding the project. This is similar to their approach to CIL funded projects.

The best way for a Parish or Town Council to raise a request for a new ITS scheme is to send the request to Melighways/EAI/SCC. They would then contact the County Councillor to see if the request is one of their local priorities to be considered. They will also coordinate/collaborate with colleagues who are working on other schemes in a locality, including Placemaking/Major Projects etc.

The process for making requests for ITS schemes through <u>@Highways/EAI/SCC</u> has not changed. The change going forward for 23/24 FY is that the County Councillor could choose to prioritise that request over others within their division and, after wider engagement with the community, have a technical appraisal carried out. They can support with a Highway Engagement Meeting if that is useful for the County Councillor to determine their local priorities.

If the request is deliverable, then the County Councillor could put that scheme forward for consideration and prioritisation for funding from the Countywide ITS budget for 23/24 FY. Since the Cabinet decision on 22 February, the ITS Forward Programmes are not agreed by the Local/Joint Committee. Also, there will be a new streamlined TRO process from 1 April so decisions on TROs for speed limits etc will then not go through the Local/Joint committees. The Road Safety / Speed limits team should be contacted regarding TROs.

Community support, including from hard-to-reach groups, and links to Greener Futures are likely to have a significant influence on the new prioritisation process for ITS schemes."

Whilst the Motion on Notice of 10 March 2022 provided an aspiration and indicated where similar schemes had been implemented, from the information provided by SCC proposals for the Godalming Primary Retail Area such as speed restrictions, traffic prohibition orders, parking restrictions and designated areas, require evidence of community support, including from hard-to-reach groups and links to Greener Futures.

Whilst Godalming Town Council had asked SCC to undertake consultation to achieve the aims of the Motion, the reality is that to enable GTC to submit a viable proposal for consideration by SCC, additional work will first need to be undertaken to be able to provide the detail required to form a basis for public consultation with residents, businesses, and community groups within the area.

If Members wish to progress the Motion of 10 March, they are asked to consider appointing suitably qualified and experienced consultants to consider the outline proposals, report on their feasibility and desirability and, following further approval by Members, support future public consultation in preparation for a submission to SCC.

At this stage, Members are asked whether Officers should continue to pursue the aim of the Motion, seek proposals and costings from appropriate consultants and prepare funding options for their engagement and any subsequent public consultation.

10. WAVERLEY AFFORDABLE HOMES DELIVERY STRATEGY – ITEM FOR DECISION

Recommendation: Members to resolve to agree that the Town Clerk and Cllr Boyle, meet with WBC officers to determine how GTC might be able to support the delivery of affordable homes, reporting back to this committee as appropriate.

Members will wish to know that the <u>Waverley Affordable Homes Delivery Strategy</u> as reported to this committee on 10 March (Min No 480-21 refers) was revised following consultation and adopted on 26 April by the Full Council of Waverley Borough.

As previously stated, Waverley believes that town and parish councils are key partners in delivering the action plan and are committed to improving the way we work in partnership with local councils. As part of this process, it is proposed that the Town Clerk and Cllr Boyle, as the Member named on the <u>Godalming Town Council Programme 2019-2023</u> document as the lead for "Supporting Waverley Borough Council in improving the provision of affordable housing" meet with WBC officers to determine how GTC might be able to support the delivery of affordable homes.
