## Opening Times

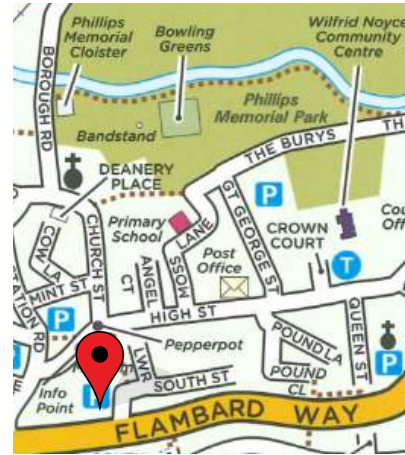
- FREE ADMISSION
