7. BROADWATER YOUTH & COMMUNITY CENTRE DECARBONISATION

Members to note that having received advice from the Planning Authority regarding the installation of PV at Broadwater Youth & Community Centre, whilst there are no concerns from a heritage perspective under Schedule 2 Part 14 Class J of the GDPO, the installation of solar panels requires planning permission if it is to be installed on a building within the curtilage of a listed building. It is not completely clear whether the community centre would be considered as building within the curtilage of a listed building, the advice was to err on the side of caution and submit a planning application.

Whilst disappointing as this will inevitably place a delay on the installation, as GTC would have to submit an application for the installation of the air source heat pumps, instructions have been given to the council's surveyors to submit, as soon as possible, a planning application to cover both the PV's and the air source heat pumps. The cost of the application to be met by the Capital Works Programme funding.
