## GODALMING TOWN COUNCIL – SUPPORTING GODALMING'S YOUNG PEOPLE

Godalming Town Council offers community grants to support local organisations. In the latest round of grant funding, the Council agreed to support the following community groups with the emphasis on the Council continuing to support the young people of Godalming:

- The Burys Scout & Guide HQ was awarded £1,500 to help make the facility fully accessible for all members of the Community.
- Godalming Junior School was awarded £1,030 to support pupils to attend educational, residential trips.
- Green Hub Project for Teens receives £1,500 who, in collaboration with Munstead Wood, helps deliver support for young people to evolve and develop their mental well-being 'journey' via social therapeutic horticulture.
- The Meath's "Every Minute Counts" project was awarded £1,500 to implement a defibrillator training programme for staff, residents and the local community.
- A community grant £1,500 was awarded to support the creation of the Joyfull Greens Community Interest Company, a plant-based community cookery school in Godalming, to help people grow, cook and eat real food to help lead healthier, happier and more sustainable lives.
